Plant Closing Notice

We regret to inform you that due to changing business conditions, Parkdale Plant 23 will be permanently closed effective April 24, 2020. It is currently anticipated that all associates will be laid-off during this period.

The purpose of this notice is to provide all affected workers notice of the closing as required by the Workers Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act. Should this closing date be extended, you will be given additional notice.

We regret the closing and its impact on so many people and their families. The plant's operations will be shut down in an orderly manner and existing customer orders will be filled. Towards that end, we ask for your continued good work and good will.

This will be a total cessation of operations. Open positions in other locations are currently limited. We will evaluate our staffing needs according to company policy. The Company will work with the local Employment Security Commission to provide assistance to plant associates in locating other employment.
